With so much attention on Washington, D. C., these days we forget the important work being done in Sacramento. Assemblyman Al Muratsuchi will catch us up on those matters that affect California. Assemblyman Muratsuchi represents the 66th Assembly District which induces Manhattan, Hermosa and Redondo Beaches, Torrance, the Palos Verdes Peninsula, West Carson, Harbor City and the southern part of Gardena. He will report on the economic health of California and what is being proposed by the State Legislature this session.

He serves as Chair, Joint Legislative Audit Committee; and Member, Appropriations; Member, Natural Resources; Member, Utilities and Energy; and Member, Veterans Affairs. He now is serving his second term in the legislature.

The Assemblyman grew up in Okinawa where his father worked for the U.S. Government. Al received his bachelor's degree from University of California, Berkeley and his law degree from U.C.L.A.
